CTT Regulations & Recommendations:

Competitors are reminded that it is now compulsory to wear a **Hard-Shell Helmet**, that meets a recognised International Safety Standard, and that **Working Front & Rear Lights** must be fitted to their machines; **no helmet**, **no lights**, **no ride**.

We will be using the Sports Lounge at H/Q, please consider others while in the Building & come prepared to wear a Face Mask if you feel more comfortable with one. A Result Board & light refreshments will be available; donations for catering would be welcome. Please do not attend the Event if you or any of your family/household are showing suspicious illness symptoms of any kind.

Course Description:

SP 462 716: **START;** In the Lay-by 200 yards west of the A45/M45 Thurlaston Island at the 3rd joint in the concrete apron. Ride West along the A45.


SP 415 732: At the Fosse Way Island, (A45/B4455), take the 2nd exit to continue on the A45.

SP 391 741: At the next Island, (A45/A445), take the 4th exit to retrace along the A45.

SP 414 732: At the Fosse Way Island, (A45/B4455), take the 2nd exit to continue on the A45.

SP 465 715: At the A45/M45 Island, take 1st exit onto the B4429 towards Thurlaston/Dunchurch.

SP 465 715: **FINISH**; 60 yards past the right turn to Thurlaston, (Main Street); in line with the Eastern (exposed) Gate Post; immediately past the property named 'Newhaven'.



Competitors Notes:

HQ Car Parking will be available from 7.30 am. Use the Gravelled area & the adjacent sports field grass as overflow Parking. Please park parallel to the hedge keeping spaces fairly regimented & reasonably compact.

Numbers & pins will only be issued to Competitors personally when they have 'Signed On'; also remember that you are required to 'Sign Off' after you ride.

Note this is a Type A Event & as such sleeveless tops are not permitted, (Regulation 16); "sleeves shall be at least mid-upper arm in length".

It is two miles from the HQ to the Start; please allow sufficient time to be ready for the Time Keeper but do not arrive more than a few minutes before your slot.

Every Competitor is to Self Start, no assistance will be allowed.

Please do not warm up on the Course once the Event has started, (09.01). NOTE: we have previously had complaints from other Competitors, particularly on the B4429 run in to the Finish, where due to riders warming up Competitors have needed to either brake or pull out in front of vehicles approaching from the rear. It also causes considerable confusion for the Finish Timekeeper. We suggest using the A45 to the East of Dunchurch, (in the direction of Willoughby & Daventry), for your warm up if necessary. Any rider failing to comply with this request risks disqualification.

We intend to present Prizes on completion of the Event. If you are able to, it would be appreciated if you could remain at H'Q until this has been completed. Any uncollected Prizes will be posted within seven days of the Event.

'Who was Diana Cooke'?

Diana was a keen Member of Coventry CC through her teenage years up until her untimely death. An ever present face on Club Runs and at Social Events, often participating in Club Time Trials. A very popular young lady amongst her peers; she was acting Editor of the Club's Magazine, 'The Milestone'. To date, no one else has ever achieved the same level of success in cajoling articles from the other Club Members for use in the magazine; (Women's Power).

During that period the Cooke's were a cycling family, Diana was the younger sister of Chris and Tony, both prominent racing members of the C's. Diana's unfortunate death came in 1983 at the tender age of 22, leaving her sadly missed by her many friends in the cycling fraternity. If she were still alive, Diana would be an Aunt to Nicole Cooke the Women's World Road Race Champion in 2003 & 2006, winner of the Women's Tours of France, Italy & Germany in 2006 and UCI ranked No.1 Women in the World in 2007. The highlight of her career obviously being her Olympic & World Championships in 2008.
